RE: KIDNAPPING & ARMED ROBBERY

The Lauderhill Police Department is seeking assistance from the public in identifying the subjects in a kidnapping and armed robbery that took place yesterday, September 18th at approximately 8:45 P.M.

The victim closed and locked the Check Cashing Store located at 2629 State Road 7 and then drove to the Inverrary Hotel located at 3501 Inverrary Boulevard in Lauderhill to attend a church service. When she was walking into a side door of the hotel she was abducted by a B/M subject armed with a black handgun. A second B/M subject stood by while was happening. The victim was forced into waiting white Dodge occupied by two additional B/M subjects. The vehicle, which has dark tint, was waiting in the parking lot. She was then taken back to the Check Cashing Store and forced to open the store, turn the alarm off and open a safe which the suspects then emptied. The suspects then left the store with the female victim and dropped her off unharmed at NW 47th Avenue and Sunrise Boulevard.

The suspects fled the area in the white Dodge. It is believed to be a base Dodge Neon or Dodge Stratus model from approximately 2003-2006. The vehicle can be seen in these photos: [1](#) [2](#) [3](#) [4](#) All of the suspects were believed to be in their 20s.
